黄桜 濁 にごり酒 - 京都

Daku Cloudy Sake - Kizakura From Kyoto, 180ml 19.8, 720ml 78.9

DAKU means Cloudy in Japanese. Cloudy sake, officially called NIGORI sake, It is pressed and divided into clear sake and the white lees. The taste is SEMI SWEET and mild with fruity nose in a perfect balance when it's brewed with the world famous Kyoto soft water Fushimizu.

一品純米酒 - 茨城 180ml 19.8, 300ml 35.9, 720ml 75.9

Ippin Junmai from, Ibaragi

Yamadanishiki Polished to 60%, this sake has a creamy texture and great balancing acidity. From the Kanto region of Ibaragi, it has hints of roasted root vegetables, eggplant, mushrooms, and toast that linger on the palate for a medium to long finish.

Ippongi Denshin Yuki Junmai-Ginjo from Fukui

This Sake has a subtle nose, lightly floral, clean and light taste, with tantalizing hints of fruit and steamed rice. Very smooth with a lengthy finish.

七田 純米酒 天山酒造 佐賀 180ml 34.9, 720ml 129.8

Shichida Junmai - Tenzan Brewing Company From Saga

This sake is Chef Shun's favourite Sake. It is clean and dry taste with fruity aroma. I remember when I got first sip of this Sake, Wow! I liked it straight away. It has a calming, sweet aroma, reminiscent of honey, as well as refreshing aroma of green apple. A refined, mild acidity completes the palate.

獺祭 純米大吟醸 磨き 4 割 5 分 - 山口

Dassai Junmai-Daiginjo 45 from Yamaguchi

180ml 32.9, 300ml 52.9, 720ml 125.9

Rice milled to an astounding 45% of it's original size.

On the palate, the apple flavour continues to inject acidity, but it is tempered with strawberries and cream, and sweet peaches. Smooth and delicious. Barely-there dryness in the finish.

Rihaku Junmai Blue Purity - Rihaku Shuzo from Shimane

This Sake has a quite complicated flavour such as a combination of Matsu pine resin, roasted chestnut and a touch of honey & bitter cacao. Dryness & Umami of Shimane local rice Kannomai is perfectly balanced.

UMESHU TASTING SET

Umeshu is Japanese plum wine, we have it as Aperitif or Dessert wine in Japan. The taste is sweet and sour, and we have little different versions as well. So if you would like to try bit of all, this tasting set is perfect for you. Or if you are full when you finished your meal, but would like to have something sweet, will be good.

チヨーヤゴールドデン梅酒 **Choya GoldeUmeshu (45ml 10.9)**

Umeshu is a traditional liqueur that has been made by Japanese families since ancient times by macerating ume (Japanese plums) in distilled sugarcane spirit. Founded in 1914, Choya is the most well-known umeshu producer in Japan. Profile: syrupy, slightly acidic. Plums in all their forms: partially dried, very ripe and perfectly sweet. Notes of spices (cinnamon) and almonds.

チヨーヤ黒糖梅酒 **Choya Kokuto Umeshu (45ml 9.8)**

Choya blend Japanese plum with unrefined sugar called KOKUTO or KURO-ZATOU, rum and black vinegar to make its taste rich, sweet & even a bit smoky. You could enjoy drinking this on the rock as a desert or even top it on vanilla ice cream for the extra sweet & rich flavour. Its just like a heaven.

The #1 selling premium rice shochu in Japan - Hakutake Shiro Kome Shochu - is clean and easy with an elegant aroma and a soft mouthfeel. Takahashi Shuzo makes it with water from the Hitoyoshi basin, which is high in minerals, and flavorful rice. Makes a perfect low-calorie vodka replacement in cocktails.

Rich, nutty, roasted shochu. The aroma is completely roasted grain while the toastiness turns sweet on the tongue. A sharp grassy finish brings you to the heart of the soba grain. Water mellows these flavors considerably and opens up a buttered caramel popcorn flavor that's absolutely delicious.

Shochu is a Japanese traditional hard liquor, distilled spirits made from grains and vegetables. The most common base ingredients are sweet potato, barley, rice, buckwheat and sugar cane. We have Rice one, Sweet potato one and Buckwheat one.

Shochu is distilled liquor, similar to brandy and vodka. However Sake is categorized as fermented liquor putting it in the same category as wine.

Grapes are both fermented to make wine and distilled to make brandy. In Japan, rice can be fermented to make Sake, or distilled to make rice Shochu. Before Sake became famous in west, it sometimes used to be referred to as "rice wine" in acknowledgement of the resemblances between wine making and Sake making.

Wine, as a fermented beverage, has a lower alcohol content than distilled liquors. Similarly, Sake, as a fermented beverage, has a lower average alcohol content (13% to 16%) than does Shochu. As a distilled beverage, Shochu has an average alcohol content of 25% to 37%. Because of its higher alcohol content, Shochu can be enjoyed in variety of ways same as whisky, like with soda water, ginger ale, or lemonade, in a cocktail, on the rock, or even with hot water in Winter. If you are interested in Shochu, we

recommend you to try our cocktails, you can taste the Shochu and easy and enjoyable to drink.
